Wed. July 7 1943 Arrived at 9:30 Found the telescope had been used and not put away. Right dome also was not turn the right way. Found a case for eyeglasses on the floor with a pencil left them at observatory. Please regardless who comes and goes enter it in the log that's the least you can do. Left at 15:00. Nice Aurora. Skipped Arc. Mag. 1st. This extended up 25° time 14:35

July 10 1943 Schoenke arrived at night. Clouds got there first. Seeing very bad. Staid until 18:00 hrs.
